The Macquarie Ancient Languages School offers a wide range of courses in Classical and Koine Greek, Latin, Egyptian Hieroglyphs, Classical Hebrew, Coptic, Akkadian, Sanskrit and others. There are also opportunities to read Greek and Roman inscriptions and coins, and Greek papyri, based on material held in the Museum of Ancient Cultures. Among the selection on offer at the 2012 Winter School are the Linear B Tablets for Mycenaean enthusiasts; Latin Vulgate Psalms from Jerome's Psalter; and Aramaic, Hieratic, and Demotic at elementary level.
