"Identity, archaeology, art and elementary education in the northwest of Argentina"



In northwestern Argentina, the native historical process started as early as **11,000 years BP** ago, interrupted in the late fifteenth century by the **Spanish Conquest and Colonization**. Since then, and during the subsequent construction of the Argentinean nationality until today, the **representation of the past** has become a field of power struggles between the **official version** promoted by primary school reaffirming a national identity and the other version encouraged by the communities supporting a reconstruction of a **new aboriginal identity**. This tense relationship is evident in a survey of archaeological knowledge, value of archaeology and other contextual data embedded within some primary schools in **indigenous communities in Northwestern Argentina**, some of which will be presented in this lecture.
