Corpus Vasorum Antiquorum: A future for ideals of the past?

Inhaltsangabe

The Corpus Vasorum Antiquorum was born almost 100 years ago from the idea that a standard of publication of all ancient vases would create a solid base for research, where before publications of ceramics were scattered and unsystematic. The series has developed, standards have changed. This paper will question whether the old ideals are still viable after so many paradigm shifts. While useful to specialists, the series fails to appeal to archaeologists from other fields. Modern technology and conceptions, like the all-connecting world of the internet and concepts like big data, open access and crowd sourcing would bring the project closer to its original ideal. And we need a change of focus and go into excavation store-rooms, rather than devoting our attention to collections with little or no contextual information.
