Matching“**

Log coffins have been discovered in caves and rockshelters in the Pang Ma Pha district, Mae Hong Son province, Northwestern Thailand. Most are made of teak wood. They have head parts carved in distinct styles and date from Iron Age 2200 BP to 900AD.
