Greek Coinage in the Achaemenid Empire. The Malayer hoard (*IGCH 1790*) and other finds



How monetised was the Achaemenid Empire? Despite recent attempts to argue for a widespread use of coinage in the eastern part of the empire, evidence remains remarkably thin. This lecture will examine the evidence of a long known, but still unpublished hoard found in Iran in 1934, and attempt to set it against the monetary context of the Achaemenid Empire of the 5th and 4th centuries BC.
