Inland Western Anatolia in the 2nd Millennium BCE: New Excavations at Aşağiseyit and Asopos

The excavations of Asopos and Aşağiseyit Höyük offer exciting new information about the cultural development of inland communities in western Anatolia, a region which has until now only been known from a few excavated settlements such as Aphrodisias, Beycesultan and Kusura. The material from the new excavations at Asopos and Aşağiseyit Höyük therefore is making a significant contribution to our understanding of this region, especially as regards the material culture and chronology. In particular, new radiocarbon dates shed light on the Middle and Late Bronze Ages, the dating of which has until now proved problematic.
