[Utrecht](#) is an old city founded by the Romans. It is located in the heart of the Netherlands on the banks of the river Rhine. Its [university](#) is more than 360 years old and is the largest in the country with about 30 000 students and seven faculties.

In addition, Utrecht has a nice, medieval city centre with canals, a number of old churches, musea, a modern concert hall and a municipal theatre. Open air markets, pubs and restaurants can easily be found. The city is also a business centre with the largest commercial fair (Jaarbeurs) of the Netherlands.

The conference will be held at the Library Complex of Universiteit Utrecht at Drift 27 in the centre of the city.
