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„Infinitives in the Rigveda”

In contrast to the Sanskrit infinitive in -tum, Early Vedic has several deverbal formations which may be classified as infinitives. In this class, their semantic and syntactic peculiarities will be analysed with the help of selected text passages.

„Periphrastic Verbal Constructions in Vedic”

In this class, various periphrastic verbal constructions (i.e., periphrastic perfect, periphrastic aorist, periphrastic future and periphrastic causative) of Vedic Old Indo-Aryan will be investigated, with special emphasis on their appearance, attestations and connection with related synthetic categories.

„Some Peculiarities of Vedic Compounds”

In this class, two interesting phenomena of Early Vedic compounds will be analysed with the help of selected text passages from the Rigveda: firstly, the so-called devatā dvandva type in its various avatars, and secondly, the accentual peculiarities of nominal compounds, first of all tatpuruṣas and bahuvrīhis.
