

**ÖLT 2020: 1<sup>st</sup> Call for Papers**

We are pleased to announce that the 46<sup>th</sup> Austrian Linguistics Conference (ÖLT 2020) will be held at the University of Vienna this year and would like to ask you to save the following date:

**December 4 to 6, 2020.**

Since its inception, the Austrian Linguistics Conference has functioned as an open forum for researchers in all areas and subfields of linguistics. In keeping with this tradition, we invite you to submit proposals for workshops and presentations in all areas of theoretical, applied and historical linguistics.

The conference will consist of the respective general sessions as well as a limited number of workshops. If you would like to organize a **workshop**, please submit your proposal (in German or English) by **August 1, 2020**. Presentations in workshops need to follow the regular conference format of **20 min + 10min discussion** to ensure compatibility with the general sessions and other workshops.

Proposals for workshops need to include:

- The title of the workshop
- A short description of the topic and purpose of the workshop (max. 400 words)
- Information on the planned number of papers
- The contact details of the workshop organizer(s)

Workshop organizers will be notified of the acceptance of their proposals by mid-August and are responsible for selecting papers and setting up the workshop programme.

For **paper presentations** in the general conference sessions and in the workshops, you are invited to submit a title and abstract (German or English, max. 300 words excluding references) by **September 1, 2020**. Abstracts should be anonymous; notification of acceptance will be sent out around the beginning of October.

Please submit your workshop proposals and abstracts for presentations via the online submission form on the conference website ([www.oelt2020.univie.ac.at](http://www.oelt2020.univie.ac.at)) and indicate whether you intend to give a poster presentation or a talk. If you would like to present in a workshop, please indicate which one. In this case, the language of abstract is determined by the workshop organizers.
