The position is situated in the OeAW long term project "Dictionary of Bavarian Dialects in Austria" ('Wörterbuch der bairischen Mundarten in Österreich', WBÖ), which is dedicated to the comprehensive documentation and lexicographic analysis of the various base and regional dialects of (historical) Austria and South Tyrol. As part of the WBÖ editorial staff, your main area of responsibility is lexicographic work, in particular writing dictionary articles which are published in the Lexical Information System Austria ('Lexikalisches Informationssystem Österreich', LIÖ) (https://lioe.dioe.at/). The WBÖ follows a modern text technological approach in which digital methods and formats (databases, XML/TEI) are of central importance. Basic technical skills and open-mindedness towards the latest developments in the field of digital humanities are therefore as much part of the requirements profile as sound knowledge in the field of dialectology and diachronic linguistics.
