Discourse & Communication is an international, peer-reviewed journal that publishes articles that pay specific attention to the qualitative, discourse analytical approach to issues in communication research. We are accepting Editor applications for a three-year term commencing January 2025.

Discourse & Communication publishes substantial research articles,

discussion notes as well as reviews and review articles. Its diversity is apparent in the variety of its theories, methods and approaches, thus avoiding the frequent limitation to one school, approach or academic sect. The journal specifically addresses readers in any field of communication who are interested in qualitative, discourse analytical approaches, on the one hand, and scholars in discourse studies, linguistics, pragmatics, semiotics and related fields who are interested in issues of communication.

The new Editor will

- Lead on the strategic development of the Journal with a particular focus on maintaining and improving quality and impact.
- Work with SAGE to ensure high-quality peer review and timely and accurate delivery of manuscripts for publication.
- Solicit, review, and make final decisions on submissions to the journal.
- Manage all aspects of the publication and review process using the Manuscript Central electronic submission and review platform.
- Managing and developing the editorial board.

Applicants should have a distinguished scholarly record in the fields of Discourse Studies and Communication Studies and experience in academic leadership roles. Applicants should also possess strong organizational and management skills, the ability to work well with others.

Those interested in making an application should send a 2-page CV, supported by a 1-page letter that outlines their experience and ability to perform the role. Expressions should specifically address the applicants' aims and vision for the Journal over the term of editorship and demonstrate the ability to commission high-quality peer-reviewed content.
