#### The Confucius Institute at the University of Vienna:

The Confucius Institute at the University of Vienna was founded  
in September 2006 and is one of the 320 Confucius Institutes  
worldwide. It is a language and cultural institute, which is  
cooperation between the University of Vienna and Hanban (the  
Department of Chinese teaching abroad under the Chinese  
Ministry of Education). The Partner university is the Beijing  
Foreign Studies University. In addition to a wide range of  
Chinese courses, the Confucius Institute at the University of  
Vienna carried out over 170 events on various aspects of  
Chinese culture since its founding. Besides to lecture and  
workshops, as well as concerts and acrobatics performances  
the Institute organized exhibition to Chinese painting,  
calligraphy and photography. The Institute also acts as a  
publisher of books on Chinese language and culture. It serves  
as a bridge between China and Austria and is cooperating with  
official Austrian authorities and international organization. In  
addition to the bilateral contract the institute would like to  
make contribution for a better understanding between cultures,  
nations and people, and particularly the Institute cooperated  
with the Vienna Office of the United Nations.
